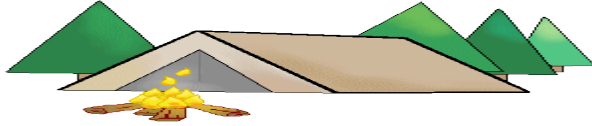
## BLIGHT

Just a reminder that City Ordinance 2.18 states that a blighted structure is "any garage, accessory or outbuilding, or any factory, shop, store, office building, warehouse or any other structure or part of a structure which: because of fire, wind, other natural disaster, or physical deterioration, is no longer habitable as a dwelling or useful for the purpose for which it was originally intended" and "is not structurally sound, weather-tight, waterproof or vermin proof."

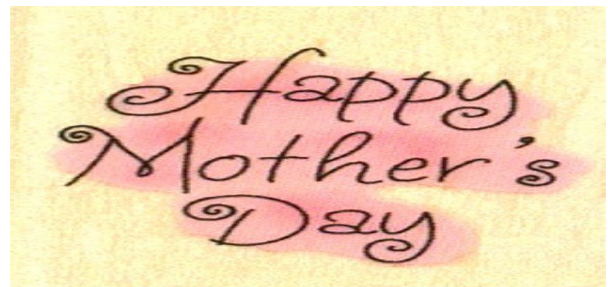
