City, Village, and Township Revenue Sharing (CVTRS) Program

The City, Village, and Township Revenue Sharing (CVTRS) Program was created by Public Act 84 of 2015 to distribute to each city, village, or township that is eligible, revenue sharing payments. Eligible units must fulfill the requirements set forth in the Act in order to receive these payments. The City of Crystal Falls has completed the requirements which include: a Citizen's Guide of the most recent finances, a Performance Dashboard, a Debt Service Report, and a Projected Budget Report that includes the current and next year's budget.

A copy of these documents is available to the public either on the City's website www.crystalfalls.org or at the City Manager's office at 401 Superior Avenue. The Dashboard and Citizens Guide are also posted in the lobby at the City Hall.

PARKING BAN REMINDER

From November 1st until May 1st, City Ordinance No. 3.02 prohibits parking on any street or alley in the City between the hours of 2:00 am and 7:00 am. Parking fines are \$15.00 for each offense. Crystal Falls Museum Society Annual Report Nov 8, 2018

The Museum was open June 1—Aug 29, Thursday Through Saturdays from 10 am—2 pm. Tours Started with Brumelie Family June 1, and Mansfield people in August. The Sports Room Display was changed and C.F. businesses artifacts were featured downstairs. New lists of East side Physicians, C.F. school teachers and staff were completed.

The births, marriages, engagements and deaths were complete from 1888 thru 2018. 30 requests were made and researched. A cemetery tour in August was given. C.F. school files and sports are organized in filing cabinets.

Members attended Northland Consortium Conference in Iron River and archival seminars. New filing cabinets were purchased and the archives are being organized. The room in the basement is a wonderful place to have for a research and restoration center now and for the future in keeping and remembering the past of Crystal Falls and the people. The archives is open all year round and used constantly.
