The City of Crystal Falls is seeking a qualified person for the position of Campground Caretaker at Runkle Lake Park for the 2018 camping season.

SEASONAL JOBS

The City of Crystal Falls is now accepting applications for seasonal, summer jobs. Generally, the jobs are for outdoor work in the cemetery/park/golf course/public works departments for **May-August**. **Applications** are available at the City Hall, front office.



EMERGENCY NOTICE: The City of Crystal Falls is issuing an emergency water "let run" due to the dangerously increasing frost levels. This is being done to protect the integrity of the entire water distribution system and ensure everyone with a continuous fresh water supply.

What does this mean to our customers?

1. City water customers need to run their water in a continuous, steady stream between the thickness of a pencil lead and a pencil from one faucet until further notice..
2. The City will bear the extra cost of the let run. Water customers will only be charged according to the average of their last 3 months water use during this let run period.
3. City water customers will need to continue to let their water run as outlined above until notified to discontinue. Please note that if a customer's water line freezes during this time, the customer will be charged a fee to have it thawed. There is always a danger when the City has to thaw water lines, so the City requests that customers please continue to run their water as outlined above. You are not wasting water, you are helping to prevent a possible catastrophic event to the City's water distribution system.
