## ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2018

On the ballot are three (3) proposals:

- 18-1 A proposed initiated law to authorize and legalize possession, use and cultivation of marijuana products by individuals who are at least 21 years of age and older, and commercial sales of marijuana through state-licensed retailers.
- 18-2 A proposed constitutional amendment to establish a commission of citizens with exclusive authority to adopt district boundaries for the Michigan Senate, Michigan House of Representative and U.S. congress, every 10 years
- 18-3 A proposal to authorize automatic and Election Day voter registrations, no-reason voting, and straight ticket voting; and add current legal requirement for military and overseas voting and post-election audits to the Michigan Constitution



IF you need to register to vote, the last day is October 9th to be able to vote this election.

IF you think you will be unable to make the polls on November 6th, please contact the Clerk's office at 906-875-3212 and ask for an absentee ballot application. The last day to apply for an absentee

ballot is Saturday, November 3rd from 8 am—2 pm.

## WINTER PARKING BAN

Beginning November 1st until May 1st each year there will be no parking allowed on the streets or alleys of the City of Crystal Falls between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.

This will be enforced by the City Police Dept. with the first snowfall that requires plowing and continues until May 1st. If there is a problem such as a disabled vehicle, call the Crystal Falls Police Department at 875-3012 as soon as possible. Parking fines are \$15.00 for each offense.

Remember! Please don't block access to the debris piles!

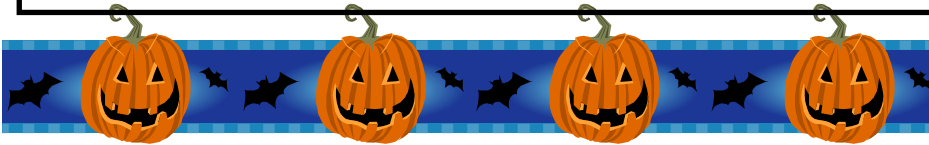

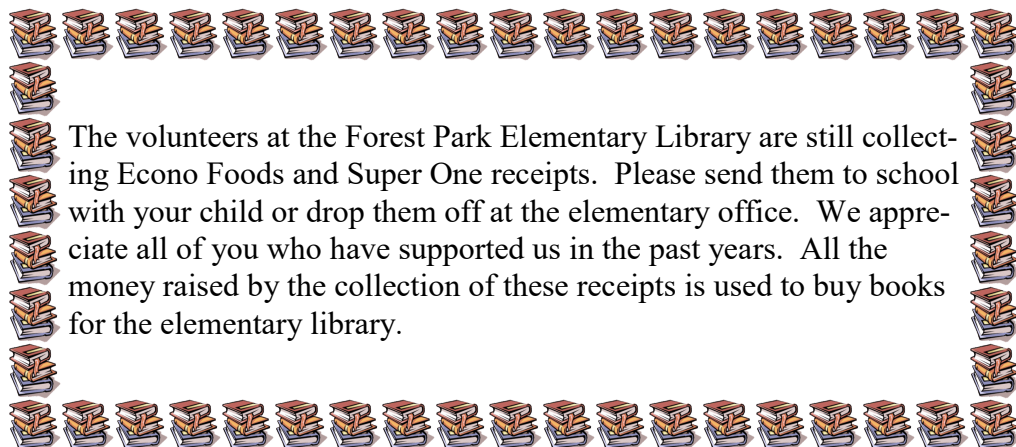
