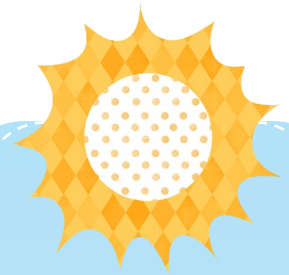
## DID YOU KNOW YOU NEED A PERMIT FOR CHICKENS?

City Ordinance 2.25 states than residents may keep hens per the following conditions:

1. Maximum of six (6) hens per lot—Roosters are prohibited
2. Chickens must be in a covered enclosure and in a fenced area
3. Permit cost is \$25
4. Permits shall be accompanied by a sketch of the property
5. Adjacent property owners need to state in writing that there is no objection

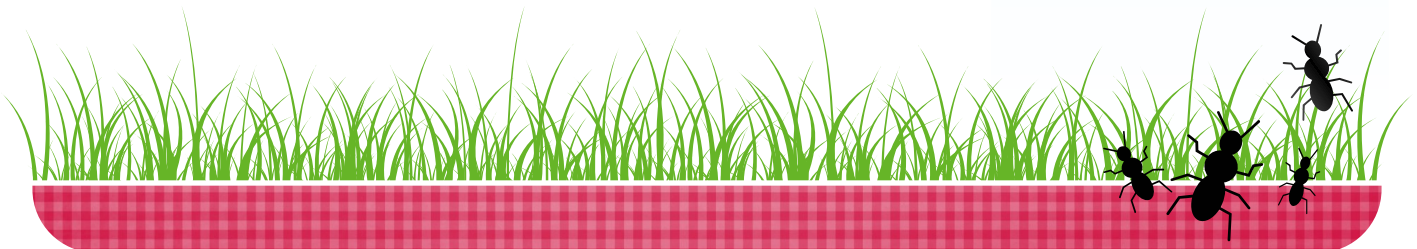

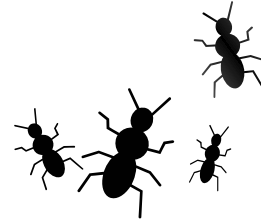
New York-based Dead Letter Office band reproduces the energy of a live R.E.M. show.



# BLIGHT

City Ordinance 2.18 states that a blighted structure is “any garage, accessory or out-building, or any factory, shop, store, office building, warehouse or any other structure or part of a structure which: because of fire, wind, other natural disaster, or physical deterioration, is no longer habitable as a dwelling or useful for the purpose for which it was originally intended” and “is not structurally sound, weather-tight, waterproof or vermin proof.”
