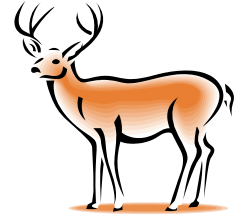

PARKING BAN IN EFFECT

STARTING NOVEMBER 1ST

Beginning with the first snowfall in November that requires plowing of the streets in the City, tickets will be issued for any vehicles that are parked on the City streets and alleyways between the hours of 2 am and 7 am. The cost of a parking fine is **\$15.00**.

The reason for this parking ban is to get the vehicles out of the way to allow the streets and alleyways to be cleared of snow. Some of the streets in the City of Crystal Falls are very challenging for our snow plow drivers, given the hilly nature of our area. Please adhere to the parking ban to help our employees safely get this task completed so you can safely get around to your destinations.

BUCK FEST 2024

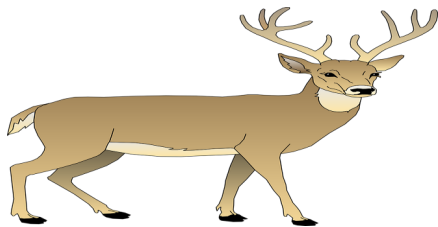
When & Where: Saturday, November 23, 2024 at 4:00p.m.— 7:00 p.m. in the City parking lot, behind the theatre.
